Key Point	When I have a problem I will focus on God.
Objective	When problems come we should focus on God rather than on our problems because He is faithful and will help us.
Memory Verse	Psalm 34:4 - I sought The Lord, and He heard me. And delivered me from all my fears.

Time	activity	Content
10.45-11.00	Worship & Birthdays	Choose from TV Library
11.00-11.10	Game (optional)	Blow up blue balloons, which will represent water from the Red Sea, and put them on the floor. Split the children into two teams, and have them stand on opposite sides of the room. Tell the children how when Moses was leading the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt, the Red Sea miraculously parted so they could escape. Show the children that you can rub a balloon on your clothes or the carpet to generate static electricity, and how it will then stick to the wall. On your mark, tell the children to each pick up a balloon, rub it on their clothes and stick it on the wall on their side of the room. As soon as a kid puts up a balloon, she can go get another one. The team with the most "water" on their wall wins
